Liturgy of the Word and Spiritual Communion for Advent

Notes

This service is intended for use on Sundays and some feast days. It is a version of the Liturgy of the Word, which turns on the Our Father into an act of spiritual communion, undertaken in the words of the *Anima Christi*.

The bulk of the service inheres in the readings and the intercessions. These will be sent out each week.

+ In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

When the Lord comes, He will bring to light things now hidden in darkness, and will disclose the purposes of the heart. Therefore, in the Light of Christ, let us confess our sins.

For the times we have been slow or failed to acknowledge Christ's authority for our lives: Kyrie eleison.

For the times when we have hidden our discipleship of Christ: Christe eleison.

For the times we have been unprepared to serve our Lord: Kyrie eleison.

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Almighty God, have mercy upon us, forgive us our sins and bring us to life eternal; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

Within Thy wounds, hide me.
Do not permit me to be separated from Thee;
From the malicious enemy defend me,
In the hour of my death call me
And bid me come to Thee,
That with Thy saints I may praise Thee;
For ever and ever. Amen.

It is appropriate that a time of reflexion follows. If, like the Vicar, you have a mind that easily lured by the frivolous and ephemeral, you might use the following to help stay on task:

Saviour eternal,
life of the world unfailing,
light everlasting
and our true redemption.
Taking our humanity
in your loving freedom,

and filled the world with joy.
