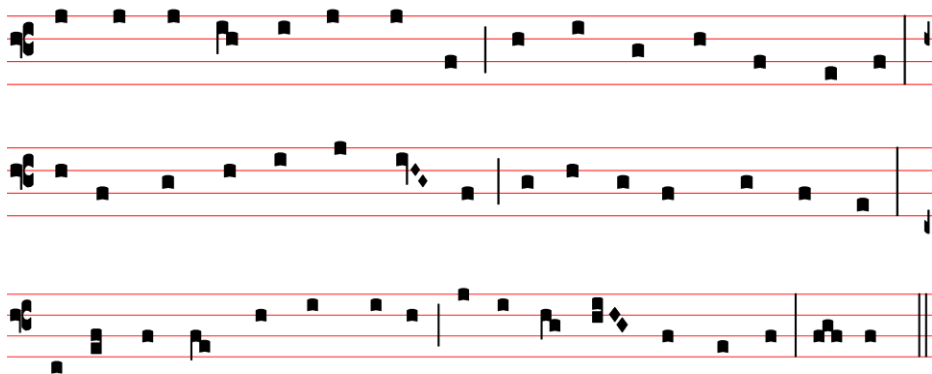


Christ, enthroned in highest Heaven,

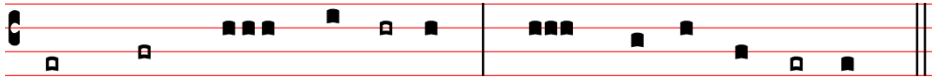

Glory be to the Father, and to the *Son* : and *to* the Holy Ghost;

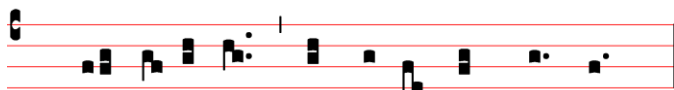
