He hath shewed *strength* with his arm : he hath scattered the proud in the *imagination* of their hearts.

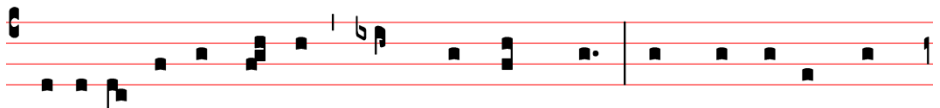
He hath put down the *mighty* from their seat : and hath exalted the *humble* and meek.

He hath filled the *hungry* with good things : and the rich he hath sent *empty* away.

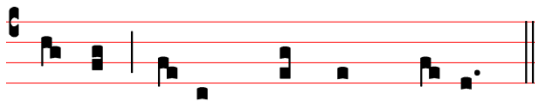
He remembering his mercy hath holpen his *servant* Israel : as he promised to our forefathers, | Abraham and his *seed*, for ever.

### THE COLLECT OF THE DAY

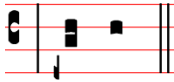

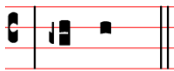
